TRADITIONAL FREE BOXING DAY GUIDED WALK

The circular walk will take in Chapel Wood, Knapp, Ampfield Wood, Lower Slackstead, farmland, paths and lanes surrounding the village, and finish walking past The White Horse and back to the Village Hall.

The walk is expected to last about 1hr. 45mins.

Stout shoes or boots should be worn as parts of the walk, especially near the end, could be very wet and muddy.

If you wish to have a hot or cold drink afterwards, **THE WHITE HORSE** will be open at the end of the walk.
